



February 22, 1732 ~ George Washington's Birthday

George Washington's Birthday was the first Federal holiday to honor an individual's birth date. In 1885, Congress designated February 22 as a holiday for all Federal workers. Nearly a century later, in 1971, the Uniform Monday Holiday Law changed the date to the third Monday in February.



February 12, 1809 ~ Lincoln's Birthday

Abraham Lincoln, the sixteenth President of the United States, was born in a single-room log cabin on Sinking Spring Farm in LaRue County, Kentucky on February 12, 1809. He was the son of Thomas Lincoln, an illiterate

pioneer farmer, and Nancy Hanks Lincoln, who died when Abraham was nine years old. It was Thomas Lincoln's second wife, Sarah Bush Johnston who, while illiterate herself, recognized Abraham's "uncommon natural talents" and encouraged his famous bookishness.

Self-taught and from humble origins, Abraham Lincoln became one of the most revered and



uniquely appealing United States Presidents. Known as Honest Abe, the Rail-splitter, and the Great Emancipator, Lincoln was a skilled orator who preserved the Union during the American Civil War and issued the Emancipation Proclamation. His assassination in 1865 contributed to Lincoln's legendary place in American history and culture.

Despite his stature among many Americans as one of the greatest United States presidents, only a small number of U.S. states, including Connecticut, Illinois, Missouri, and New York, observe Lincoln's birthday on February 12 as a legal, public holiday. In other states, Lincoln's birthday is celebrated in combination with President George Washington's birthday on the third Monday of each February. The combined federal holiday is officially named Washington's Birthday but is also known as **Presidents Day.**

Be Strong Youth ...

Continuing down the Bible timeline, our "Be Strong Bible Club" has been intrigued to follow along with Joshua as he leads the Israelites into the promised land. One night, the youngsters spread out in different corners of the room, manned with a cotton ball and tape on the floor. They were challenged to see how far they could move their cotton, using a single breath. Wouldn't it be amazing if we could topple the walls of the fellowship hall, with one steady blow? Pondering that, we peered into the Bible, to see how God asked











His people to use their breaths in a completely unexpected way! Although they must have groaned at the sight of the high, wide walls of Jericho, the Israelites knew swords alone could never help them take the city. When the Captain of the Lord's army appeared to Joshua, His battle plan was anything but ordinary.

God's orders must have seemed so unusual, yet Joshua and his people were prepared to obediently follow the strange strategy – quietly marching around the city *once* for six consecutive days; then, on the seventh day, walking around the walls seven times, and having seven priests blow their trumpets. When the horns blew, Joshua said unto the people, 'Shout; for the Lord hath given you the city.' (Joshua 6:16) What an incredible way for the Lord to show His people that He was with them while they faced their first opponents in the promised land... the mighty walls of Jericho fell to the ground, leaving nothing but piles of rubble! As promised, while the city was being destroyed, Rahab and her family were kept safe... noted by the scarlet cord she hung in her window. From then on, she and her family lived with God's people, following the one true God. What a blessing to show the children how Rahab's family would later become the ancestors of Jesus Himself, born through the tribe of Judah many generations later!

As always, we appreciate your prayers for our young people. This winter has been challenging so far, as they face the rise in Covid cases. While some schools close, we have also taken a brief break from fellowship hall meetings, in an effort to help stop the spread. But we have kept in touch with one another through zoom meetings. As our youngsters virtually gather to pray and share their burdens, we find that lifting our requests up to the Lord binds us together in a special way. "Great Love"

"But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us," (Ephesians 2:4)

These two words, "great love," constitute a majestic subject with the approach of a day, in our culture, designated as "Valentine's Day." Love is the theme of the occasion. The day is accompanied with expressions of love demonstrated in words and deeds. Oftentimes, the candy, the card, or the ring, say, "I love you." Understand, however, that no human attempt at the expression of love can match, "his great love wherewith he loved us."! No human match can be found because of the origin, object, and outcome of this "great love."

Notice the Origin of this Great Love. "But God" ~ This great love is associated with a great God! It could be no other way. The love of friends and family is a precious treasure. Yet, all human love is flawed. Friends and even family relationships have been known to become shattered because of life's circumstances. All of the combined languages of this earth fall short in containing enough adjectives to exhaust the full glorious description of the love of God. His love can be described, among countless other ways, as being eternal, unconditional, sacrificial, personal, effectual, and unchanging. The Prophet spoke of God's eternal love. "The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee." (Jer.31:3) "Could we with ink the ocean fill, And were the skies of parchment made, Were every stalk on earth a quill, And every man a scribe by trade; To write the love of God above Would drain the ocean dry; Nor could the scroll contain the whole, Though stretched from sky to sky."

Notice the Object of this Great Love. "He loved us" ~ This great love involves the world of "great sinners!"
